

Perennial Lavender gift bag


The project:



Supplies:

- Very Vanilla card measuring 7" x 5-3/4" for the hox
 - score the long side at 2-1/4", 3-1/4",5-1/2" and 6-1/2"
 - o score the short side at 1" and 4-3/4"
 - score the long side from top to first horizontal score line at 2-3/4" and
 6"
- Perennial Lavender DSP measuring
 - o 2" x 3-1/2" (two pieces)
 - o 2" x 3/4" (one piece)
- Very Vanilla card cut with Perennial Postage die
- Painted Lavender die cuts to decorate
- Linen thread
- dimensionals
- embellishments
- bag of lavender to pop inside

Assemble the bag



- Add diagonal score lines as shown in green on Photo 1
- Fold and burnish the score lines shown as dashed pencil lines in Photo 1
- cut along the red solid lines shown in Photo
 Removing all the pieces marked with an X.
- Photo 2 overleaf shows how it should now look
- Burnish the diagonal score lines you added. Line up a ruler along the score line then bend the card over it (see photos 3 & 4). Once you've done this to can make the crease even neater with a bone folder as shown in Photo 5)





- OPTIONAL punch or round the corners of the top (lid) and the DSP to fit this panel.
- NOTE if your paper is directional you need to punch the bottom 2 corners, not the top ones. You'll also need to glue this to your base upside down at this stage
- add your designer series paper to the central panels and the lid, as shown in photos 6 & 7
- Add glue to the side tab and adhere to the back of the first panel
- Fold and glue the tabs to form the base of the box – make sure you fold the front one last for a neat finish
- Stamp your sentiment on the square die cut provided
- Add foliage die cuts to the front of the bag, wind twine around and tie at the top
- add the sentiment over the twine with dimensionals either side of the twine.
- add embellishments
