

## Unbounded Beauty Book Style Gift Box

June 2024 in person & class in the mail instructions

### The project:

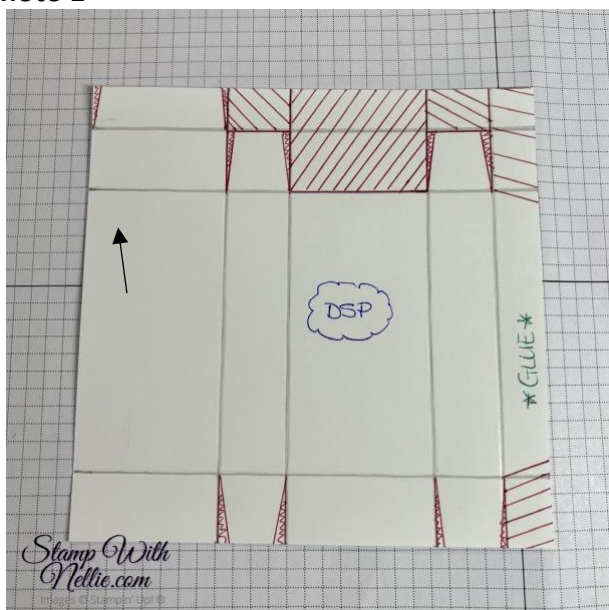


### Supplies:

- 2024-2026 In Color card measuring 5-1/8" x 3-1/2"
  - score on the long side at 1-3/4" & 3-3/8"
- Basic White card (2 pieces) measuring 5-1/4" x 5-1/4"
  - score the first side at 1-5/8", 2-3/8", 4" & 4-3/4"
  - score the second side at 3/4", 4" & 4-3/4"
- Unbounded Beauty DSP measuring
  - 1-3/8" x 3" (2 pieces for box fronts)
  - 1-1/2" x 3-1/4" (2 pieces for cover)
  - 1-3/8" x 3-1/4" (for spine of cover)
- Basic White card for the sentiment circle
- Scraps of In Color card for die cuts
- In Color ribbon
- embellishments

### Assemble the box

### Make the internal boxes

- Fold and burnish all of the score lines on the white card for the 2 boxes
- Cut the lines in red in Photo 1 to remove the sections with red diagonal lines
- Add the DSP to the section indicated

#### IMPORTANT STEP –

- Before you assemble the box use the Heartfelt Hexagon punch to create a thumb not on the DSP panel – your boxes should look like Photo 2
- Add glue to the side tab and adhere to the back of the first panel
- Fold and glue the tabs to form the base of the box – make sure you fold the front one last for a neat finish
- Pop your tea light candles inside and fold and close the top.

#### Prepare the cover

- Fold and burnish the score lines
- Add Tear & Tape to the front and back sections to secure your ribbons
- Add your 3 pieces of DSP to the cover – the spine of the cover is narrower than the front and back so make sure you use the right pieces for each panel!

#### Assemble the project

- Add glue to the back of the internal boxes
- Line up the sides of the boxes with the scorelines on the cover. There should be a gap at the top, bottom and outside edge only – see Photo 3
- Stamp and die cut your sentiment
- Arrange die cuts on the front of the cover, add the sentiment with dimensionals
- Embellish as required
- Tie your ribbons
